



MBA/MS in Chemistry



Master of Business Administration/Master of Science in Chemistry



Overview

This innovative combined degree program, the Master of Business Administration/Master of Science in Chemistry with a Chemical Business concentration, is designed for individuals with a bachelor's degree in chemistry or biochemistry who wish to advance their careers in the chemical and pharmaceutical industries.

Generally, individuals who are interested in areas such as research and development, or production and quality assurance, complete an MS. Individuals who are interested in areas such as management, marketing and sales complete an MBA. Some professionals complete both degrees during their careers.

Our dual degree program at Montclair State University serves students who wish to further their knowledge in a particular discipline and obtain management training at the same time. This MBA/MS in Chemistry program is designed for talented and motivated students who wish to enhance their opportunities for advancement within the chemical and pharmaceutical industry by obtaining both degrees in a shorter time period (62 credits) than would be required for completion of both degrees separately.

Concentrations

MBA/MS in Chemistry students may choose to pursue a general MBA or select one or two concentrations in the following areas:

- Accounting
- Finance
- International Business
- Management
- Management Information Systems
- Marketing

Admission Requirements

There is no admission deadline: applications are reviewed on a rolling basis. If you are interested in completing the MBA portion of this dual degree through the Saturday-only program at Brookdale, please note that only one cohort starts each year in that program (usually in February).

Apply well in advance of your preferred start date, to ensure a comprehensive review of your application.

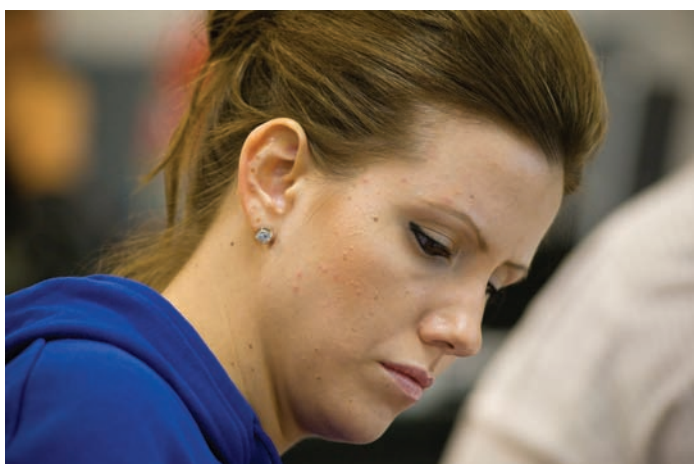
You apply to the MBA/MS in Chemistry program through Graduate Admissions.

An application includes:

- An earned baccalaureate degree (or the foreign equivalent) in Chemistry or Biochemistry documented with a transcript
- One official copy of the academic transcript from each college and/or university attended
- GMAT scores
- A personal statement
- Two letters of recommendation
- The application fee

International students also must submit:

- TOEFL scores
- A course-by-course evaluation from World Educational Services (WES) of your degree transcript, if from a non-U.S. university
