Making Your Saturdays Work for You

- The Saturday-only MBA is an accelerated program designed to fit the schedules of busy professionals.
- You can complete the Montclair State University MBA in just two years, taking classes only on Saturdays.
- Courses in the Saturday-only MBA are held on the campus of Brookdale Community College in Lincroft, New Jersey.
- All courses are taught by the same School of Business faculty as on our main Montclair campus.
- The MBA at Brookdale is a cohort-based program, so you progress through the program as part of a team.
- MBA classes are small (usually no more than 25 students), allowing for a high level of interaction with faculty and fellow students.

Courses and Concentrations

The Saturday-only MBA is designed as a general degree and all the courses required for the MBA are offered at the Brookdale campus. If you wish to pursue a concentration, you may take the necessary concentration electives on our main campus in Montclair.

You can select one or two concentrations in the following areas:

- Accounting
- Finance
- International Business
- Management
- Management Information Systems
- Marketing

Advanced Standing

If you have an undergraduate business degree you may be eligible for advanced standing in the MBA program. For more information, please visit our Web pages at www.montclair.edu/mba.

Depending on your eligibility for advanced standing, you will complete 33-48 credits for your Montclair State University MBA.



Admission Requirements

To apply, see www.montclair.edu/graduate

Please be sure to select Brookdale MBA (Communiversity) on the application.

An application includes:

- An earned bachelor's degree from a regionally-accredited college or university
- One official copy of the academic transcript from each college and/or university attended
- GMAT scores
- A personal statement
- Two letters of recommendation
- The application fee

International students also must submit:

- TOEFL scores
- A course-by-course evaluation from World Educational Services (WES) of your degree transcript, if from a non-U.S. university



There is no admission deadline: applications are reviewed on a rolling basis. But applicants should note that only one cohort starts each year in the Saturday-only MBA program. Brookdale Cohorts normally begin their MBA program in late February of each year. Apply well in advance of your preferred start date to ensure a comprehensive review of your application.

Frequently Asked Questions

If this is an all-Saturday program, when do I have time off?

There are no classes on major holiday weekends, and a Saturday break follows the end of each 10-week term. Longer breaks are scheduled around Christmas/New Years and in the summer.

Is this MBA program accredited?

Yes. The School of Business at Montclair State University is accredited by AACSB International for all our degree programs—including the Saturday-only MBA at Brookdale.

Are there any prerequisites for the MBA ?

The only prerequisite is an undergraduate course in calculus.

If you didn't take calculus as an undergraduate, you may apply and be accepted to the Montclair MBA on a deferred or conditional basis, taking the required calculus course before you enroll in the basic MBA courses for which it is a prerequisite.
