MBA Minimum Credit Requirements: 33 SH, depending upon advanced standing. Students with no advanced standing and one or no concentration complete 48 SH; those choosing the double concentration option complete 57 SH. (See Category IV below)

Categories I & II: Students without sufficient prior coursework in the Business disciplines to qualify for advanced standing complete 24 SH of Basic MBA courses.

Advanced Standing: students with prior degrees in Business or related majors may be eligible for advanced standing in Categories I & II, reducing MBA requirements by up to 5 courses (15 SH). Eligibility is determined after acceptance to the MBA program.

ADVANCED COURSES: All advanced courses must be taken at MSU.

Category III: Students may be eligible for advanced standing in these courses, but this does not reduce the degree credits requirement. Those who are determined to be eligible may substitute an equivalent number of authorized elective courses, as follows:

- ACCT 502: substitute any course from the MBA electives.
- ECON 505: substitute any course from the MBA electives.
- INBS 501: substitute any course from the International Business MBA electives [or any elective course cross-listed with INBS].

Category IV: All students complete at least three (3) [elective courses](#) (9 SH). A general MBA, without a concentration, is earned by selecting any 3 courses from the MBA electives.

Single/Double Concentration(s): A concentration is 3 courses (9 SH) from a designated electives list. The double concentration option requires 3 electives in each discipline, for a total of 18 SH. Students may complete a concentration in one or two of the following areas:

- [Accounting](#): 3 Accounting elective courses.
- [Finance](#): 3 Finance elective courses.
- [International Business](#): 3 International Business elective courses.
- [Management](#): 3 Management elective courses.
- [MIS](#): 3 MIS elective courses.
- [Marketing](#): 3 Marketing elective courses.

Category V: All students must complete both Capstone courses, either concurrently or in separate terms. Before enrolling in MGMT 580 or MGMT 513, students must complete all required Basic and Advanced MBA courses (Categories I, II and III).
